## RIDE & TIE RACE SEASON STARTS NEXT MONTH

Happy February to all Ride & Tiers everywhere from the Association. As the calls come into the Association it is plain that many of us are itching to get out there and get some ridin' & tyin'in.

### 20th Annual World Ride & Tie Championship Slated for July 14

Trinidad, California will be the place to be on July 14, 1990. Two decades of Ride & Tying will be celebrated at this year's Championship Race. Race Directors Ted & Joan Ruprecht are hard at work with their support crew preparing for the event. Come see some beautiful country and have a good time on the North Coast of California.

As reflected in the schedule in this newsletter the first ride & ties of the season kick off in March with the Pt. Reyes Ride & Tie practice and the R & R Ride & Tie in Idaho. Since the last publication a new Ride & Tie has been added to the schedule. Cliff, Kathy and Tom Lewis of Nevada are hosting a sanctioned Ride & Tie on June 17 near Gardnerville, Nevada. This is just south of Carson City and this race should be a good warm up for the World Ride & Tie Championship the following month.

Speaking of sanctioned Ride & Ties, the 1989 National Ride & Tie Point system Champions are posted in this newsletter. This was our first year of recognizing these individuals. The results and tabulations were done by Rick Appleton of the Point System committee. Our thanks to Rick for his work on this ongoing project. If you are interested in competing in this category the first sanctioned Ride & Ties of the year are the Wildflower Ride & Tie near Los Angeles and the Mountainside Ride & Tie near Redding, CA. The National Point System was created to encourage more participation in local Ride & Ties and also to recognize those Ride & Tiers who compete all year long.

### RIDE & TIE GET TOGETHER IN RENO

We are holding a Ride & Tie get together and dinner in Reno, Nevada on March 9th.
