- *All participants must be members of the Ride and Tie Association.*
- Full members can each take a discount at a discount.
- One-day memberships must be done with the Ride and Tie association at <u>www.rideandtie.org</u> at least 48 hours before the event.
- Contact the Ride & Tie association to check membership currency and number.
- All juniors must wear helmets.
- Please review the Ride and tie rules before the event.
- The ride manager has the right to adjust the rules for this event.
- This event allows the crew to handhold vet checks located at Knickerbocker and Aloha crossing only.
- All camping must be pre-arranged with the ride manager before the event.
- *VETTING:* Horses can be vetted on Friday night from 5-7 pm and encouraged to decrease urgency in the morning.
  - o Long course RAT horses Vet in/Vet check/Vet out.
  - o Short course RAT horse Vet in (Pulse, trot) and Vet out
  - Equation horses LONG/SHORT Vet in/Vet out. PULSE TIME is the finishing time and PULSE card must be given to Vet.
- Equathon: Horses and riders leave at the same time. Finish time is Runner time+ Horse PULSE down time written on pulse card and provided to vet.
- *IRON MAN:* Must leave within 15 minutes of finishing horse portion. Can have crew pulse and vet horse and must let timers know when they are leaving.
- Children may have a lead line attached for safety.
- Tie horses to trees, NO posts, fences, gates. Inspect the area where intending to tie for safety. Ride and tie- YOU can stay together and just switch.
- **Drinks and lunch at the finish line for participants.** Use the ticket stapled to the registration envelope for lunch.
- All dogs must be leashed.



• All Vehicles must have a parking pass visible! Cars in car lot only.

- The park is open to the public. Be courteous to hikers, bikers, riders, and dog walkers.
